EDUCATION

Hernando County Schools:

- Distance/virtual learning begins Monday, March 30th for all Hernando County schools Please contact your child's teacher with any questions.
- All Hernando children age 18 and under are eligible to receive free meals during these school closures. Child must be present to receive food. Visit HCSB website for schedule/drop off flyer.
- As of March 20th, childcare facilities have not been ordered to close.
- Check with your local daycare or childcare agency to ensure they are still in operation
